

## Tom Dyer Drives Again and Scores Top 5 Finish at Watkins Glen International Raceway

### 5th place finish is the team's best result in 2011

June 6, 2011 (Watkins Glen, NY) - Taking advantage of another opportunity to drive in the Continental Tire Sports Car Challenge (CTSCC) Series, Tom Dyer and co-driver Tony Rivera brought the CKS Autosport #01 Chevy Camaro home in 5th place, giving the team their highest finish of the year. Competing in the GS class for the second consecutive weekend the race took place at the historic Watkins Glen International Raceway in New York. After qualifying the car in 9th position Dyer started the two and a half race cleanly working his way up to 6th place and lapping with the lead pack. After a full course caution and some cars making pit stops Dyer took over the lead of the race. Throughout his driving stint and while leading, Dyer had great battles with many of the top cars and drivers showing his ability to compete and excel in the CTSCC series.

Finishing off his stint behind the wheel and needing fuel Tom pitted just after the one hour mark handing the car over to his teammate Tony Rivera. With some great pit stop strategy and driving from the team and Tony the #01 Camaro stayed near the front of the field throughout the race carding the season high 5th place at the checkered flag.

***"It was great to be behind the wheel of the #01 and racing in CTSCC series for the second consecutive weekend. In our previous race at Lime rock we felt we had top five potential so it's great to achieve it with this finish here at the Glen. The series is fiercely competitive and I really need to take my hat off to Tony and team. He's an awesome teammate and they nailed the race strategy. They called the pit stops perfectly ensuring that we had enough fuel at the end of the race and kept us near the front when it counted. I really welcome the opportunity to race some more in this series."***

**Series Overview:**

The Continental Tire Sports Car Challenge (CTSCC) is a sports car racing series where many different makes and models compete against each other in production based street cars that are modified according to what's allowed by the rules. There are two separate classes racing simultaneously with the Grand Sport (GS) and Street Tuner (ST) divisions. The GS is comprised of muscle cars and imports like Camaro's, Mustang's, BMW's, Porsche's and Nissan's. The ST class is populated by cars with smaller engine displacement like VW's, Honda's, Mazda's and Mini Coopers.
