



## TOM DYER IS READY TO TAKE ON NEW CHALLENGES THIS MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

Dyer set to debut in the Grand-Am Continental Tire Sports Car Challenge Series at Lime Rock Park Lakeville, CT (May 25, 2011) - Tom Dyer will climb behind the wheel of the #01 CKS Autosport Chevrolet Camaro this weekend making his first career appearance in the Grand-Am Continental Tire Sport Car Challenge (CTSCC) series this Saturday, May 28th. It also marks Dyer's first visit to the picturesque Lime Rock Park race track in Lakeville, CT. He'll be substituting for regular driver Dave Mundy and share driving duties with highly respected sports car driver Tony Rivera. The CTSCC sports car races utilize two drivers per car and the races cover two and half hours in length.

*"I'm excited to be racing in the CTSCC series this weekend. It's a very healthy series in terms of competitiveness, car counts and it's stacked with many talented drivers, so it's going to be an excellent opportunity to see what it's like from behind the steering wheel instead of watching it on TV. ### SERIES OVERVIEW:

The CTSCC is a sports car racing series where many different makes and models compete against each other in production based street cars that are modified according to what's allowed by the rules. There are two separate classes racing simultaneously with the Grand Sport (GS) and Street Tuner (ST) divisions. The GS is comprised of muscle cars and imports like Camaro's, Mustang's, BMW's, Porsche's and Nissan's. The ST class is populated by cars with smaller engine displacement like VW's, Honda's, Mazda's and Mini Coopers. Dyer will be competing in the Grand Sport (GS) division, which is the faster of the two. All the cars compete on Continental Tire racing slicks designed and engineered specifically for the series.
